

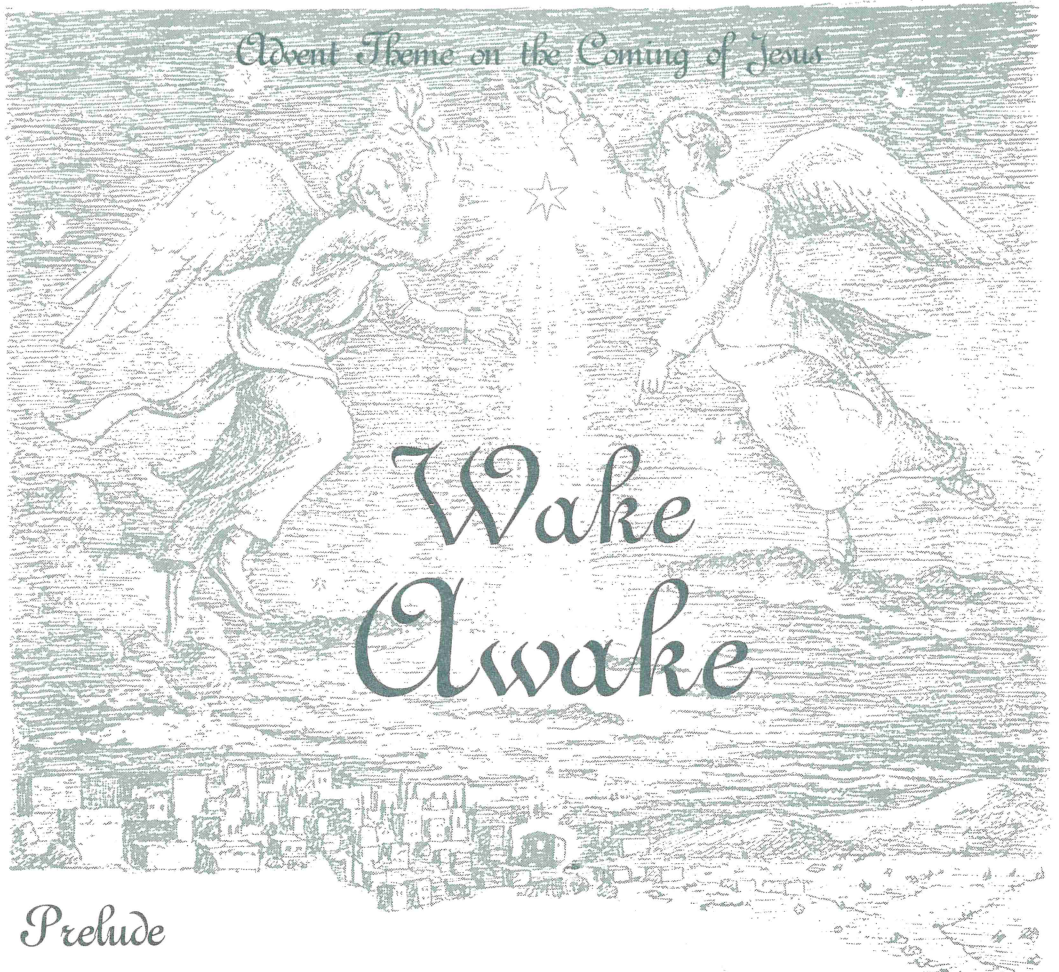

## *About Christmas with Wartburg*

Christmas with Wartburg traditionally opens the Advent-Christmas season as a musical celebration of Christ's Incarnation. The Wartburg Choir, Concert Band and Castle Singers unite to present this program of word and song.

Last year, 6,400 people attended Christmas with Wartburg performances in Waverly, Cedar Falls and Des Moines. Iowa Public Television taped the 1989 production, which was aired in both 1989 and 1990. It will be broadcast again this year on Dec. 24 at 11 a.m.

Students in the three music organizations are chosen by audition and represent almost every academic discipline on campus. They make annual concert tours in the United States and travel abroad every fourth year. The Wartburg Choir toured Europe last May, and the Concert Band will make its sixth European tour in the spring of 1993.

This year, the Choir will tour in Iowa, Colorado and South Dakota during the college's Winter Term Break, Feb. 22- March 1. The Castle Singers will travel to Florida, and the Concert Band will tour in Iowa, Wisconsin and Minnesota during Tour Week, April 17-26.

## About the Directors



**Dr. Herman Diers**, professor of religion at Wartburg, is not only the narrator, but the guiding force behind the Christmas with Wartburg programs. Early in the year, he consults with the music directors and begins weaving musical selections and Scripture readings together to create the Christmas with Wartburg theme.



**Dr. Robert E. Lee**, director of bands at Wartburg since 1959, has been cited by *The School Musician Magazine* as one of the outstanding educational conductors in the United States and Canada. His background includes nine years of teaching grades 1-12 in public schools. He is a frequent guest conductor for festival bands.



**Dr. Paul Torkelson**, director of choral activities since 1984, directs the Wartburg Choir, the Castle Singers and the Women's Choir. A 1976 Wartburg graduate, he was a member of the choir as a student. He made his conducting debut at Carnegie Hall in May 1989 and has directed a number of All-State choruses.

## About Wartburg College

Wartburg College, Waverly, Iowa, is a four-year liberal arts college of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. It is named after the Wartburg Castle, a landmark that stands on a wooded hilltop overlooking Eisenach, Germany. During the stormy days of the Reformation, Martin Luther took refuge at the castle, and today, it is one of Germany's most popular tourist attractions. Wartburg music groups traditionally visit the castle during their European tours, and it is a favorite stop on alumni trips.

Wartburg enrolls 1,450 students and is listed as one of the country's top 141 liberal arts colleges in *U. S. News & World Report's* annual "Best Colleges" survey. It is the only private college in Iowa to offer a major in music therapy. This year, the campus celebrates the opening of a \$4.25 million Fine Arts Center, which provides new facilities for programs in music, music therapy and art.
