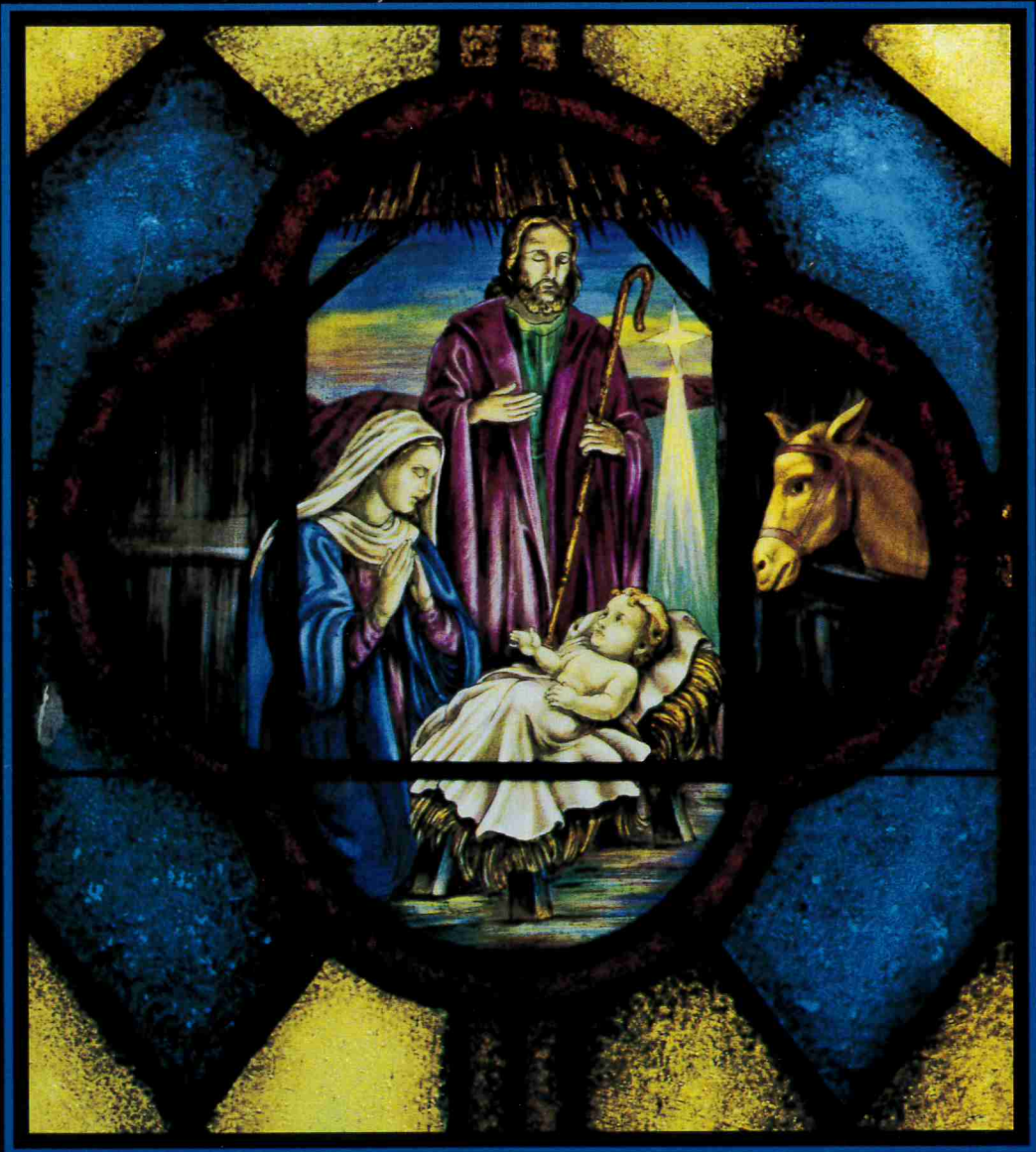

CHRISTMAS WITH WARTBURG 1994

Christmas with Wartburg traditionally opens the Advent-Christmas season as a musical celebration of Christ's incarnation. The Wartburg Choir, Concert Band, and Castle Singers unite to present this program as the college's Christmas gift to Iowa. Last year, more than 6,400 persons attended performances on campus, at Nazareth Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls, and at the Des Moines Civic Center. Iowa Public Television broadcast the 1991 production, and *Midwest Living* magazine highlighted the annual program in this year's December issue.

Students in the three music organizations are chosen by audition and represent almost every academic discipline on campus. The groups make annual concert tours in the United States and travel abroad every fourth year. During this year's May Term, the Wartburg Choir will tour in Europe. The performance schedule includes a concert in the Great Hall of the Wartburg Castle, namesake of the college. The Castle Singers spent last year's May Term in Australia. This year, they will tour during Winter Term Break, Feb. 18-26, in western Iowa, Nebraska, South Dakota, and southwestern Minnesota. The Concert Band will travel to Florida April 14-23, with concerts also scheduled in Illinois, Tennessee, and Georgia. The band's next tour abroad will be in 1997.

The Directors



Dr. Robert Vogel, president of Wartburg College, narrates this year's Christmas with Wartburg performances. It is a fitting role for the 1956 Wartburg alumnus, who was a Lutheran pastor and church administrator before accepting the call in 1980 to serve as Wartburg's 14th president. Vogel has been a strong advocate of Lutheran higher education and Wartburg's mission of challenging and nurturing students for lives of leadership and service as a spirited expression of their faith and learning.



Dr. Robert E. Lee, director of bands and professor of music, most recently portrayed march king John Philip Sousa in the Wartburg Concert Band's Sousa replica concert Nov. 6. That evening, he was in Davenport to conduct the Quad Cities Wind Ensemble in a similar musical tribute to Sousa. This is Lee's last Christmas with Wartburg season. He will retire at the end of the 1994-95 academic year after a distinguished 37-year career at Wartburg. In 1990, band alumni honored Lee by donating more than \$40,000 in his name toward construction of the new Wartburg Fine Arts Center.



Dr. Paul Torkelson, director of choral activities and associate professor of music, directs the Wartburg Choir, the Castle Singers, and the Meistersinger Choir. A 1974 Wartburg graduate, Torkelson sang in the Wartburg Choir as a student and returned as its director in 1984. He made his Carnegie Hall conducting debut in May 1989. Torkelson is a frequent guest conductor for all-state choirs throughout the country. He will conduct the 50th anniversary Iowa All-State Chorus in 1996.



The Rev. Philip Froiland, retired director of church relations, works with the music directors to shape the Christmas with Wartburg program, integrating the music with the central message of Christmas. Until his retirement last summer, Froiland handled the administrative details of this annual Christmas production. He deserves much of the credit for the growth of the program over the past several years.

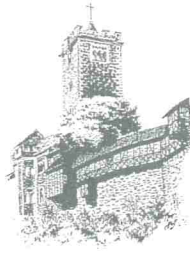

A RICH HERITAGE

Wartburg College is a four-year liberal arts college of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. It is named after the Wartburg Castle, a landmark that stands on a wooded hilltop overlooking Eisenach, Germany. During the stormy days of the Reformation, Martin Luther took refuge at the castle, and today, *Die Wartburg* is one of Germany's most popular tourist attractions.

In April, the Wartburg Choir will sing in the Great Hall of the castle as part of a one-month concert tour of Europe.

Wartburg enrolls 1,400 students and is listed among the country's top 164 liberal arts colleges in *U.S. News & World Report's* annual "Best Colleges" survey. It is one of only 111 colleges nationwide named to the John Templeton Foundation's Honor Roll for Character Building Colleges, a list that recognizes schools promoting integrity as well as knowledge.
