We are excited to invite you to nominate your highest achieving high school singers to participate in the **Meistersinger** Honor Choir Festival on Sunday, January 26 and Monday, January 27, 2025!

The Meistersinger Honor Choir Festival is designed to bring together the finest singers from high schools across the region to collaborate with world-class artists and perform their music with the highest level of artistry. We are pleased to welcome composer and conductor, **Dr. Marques L.A. Garrett**, as our artist-in-residence, whose music will also be featured at the festival.

This year's festival will be comprised of two festival choirs: the Meistersinger Mixed Honor Choir under the direction of Dr. Lee Nelson, and the Meistersinger Treble Honor Choir under the direction of Dr. Nicki Toliver. Due to the challenging nature of the repertoire, the nomination process is dependent upon the director comments which list student's accomplishments, musical abilities, and work ethic. Please carefully consider that all director comments and rankings of tone quality, intonation, rhythm, and musicianship for each nominated student, compliment each other. Each nomination will be closely reviewed to select the finest musicians from each school. Because of the competitive nature of the festival, it is important to note that not every nominee may be accepted.

Accepted singers will have the opportunity to submit a video of a solo performance to be considered for a complimentary voice coaching with our Wartburg voice faculty and a performance of their solo for the 350+ festival participants. These students will also be recognized at the Finale Concert with a certificate of achievement.

Registration for the festival is \$60 per singer. A limited number of on-campus housing will be available.
