College Student Inventory (CSI) Administration and Distribution of Results

CSI Administration Process

The paper-based version of the College Student Inventory (CSI) is administered to all incoming first-year students who attend Summer Orientation, Advising, and Registration (SOAR). Incoming first-year students who do not attend SOAR are provided with a link to complete the online version of the CSI. International students are administered the paper-based version of the CSI during Fall Orientation.

CSI Distribution of Results

Coordinator Reports

Prior to the start of the academic year, IS 101 and SCH 101 faculty receive a copy of the coordinator report for each student in their section of IS 101 or SCH 101. Academic advisors receive a copy of the coordinator report for each of their first-year advisees. Additionally, the Director of Multicultural Student Services also receives a copy of the coordinator report for all incoming, first-year American ethnic students.

Student Reports

Student reports are distributed to each student's IS 101 or SCH 101 professor. It is the responsibility of the IS 101 and SCH 101 faculty to individually share the student report with each of the students enrolled in their class.

Academic Support

A report identifying students who may benefit from writing, reading, or speaking support is sent to the Director of the Writing, Reading, Speaking Lab (WRSL).

Counseling Support

A report identifying students who may benefit from counseling support is sent to the Director of Counseling Services.

Financial Guidance

A report identifying students who may benefit from financial guidance is sent to the Director of Financial Aid.

Social Enrichment

A report identifying students who may benefit from social enrichment activities is sent to the Director of Residential Life.

Vocational & Career Support

A report identifying students who may benefit from vocational support or career counseling is sent to the Director of Career Services.

Summary and Planning Report

A summary and planning report, which identifies the strengths and challenges of the incoming class as a whole is sent to the Vice President for Enrollment Management.
