Wartburg College SARS-CoV-2/COVID-19 Mitigation Policy

Vaccination

- Wartburg College encourages students, faculty, and staff to be up-to-date on their COVID-19 vaccines, including a booster dose based on eligibility.
- All individuals are encouraged to <u>upload their proof of vaccination</u>.

Masking

- Wartburg College observes a mask-optional policy.
- While masks are not required in community spaces on campus, individuals may require others to wear a mask while in their personal work or living space. This includes, but is not limited to, the classroom, personal offices, and residence hall rooms.
- Individuals should carry a mask with them at all times so they are prepared should a request arise.

Testing

- Wartburg community members who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should contact the Noah Campus Health Clinic at 319-352-8436 or their primary health care provider immediately.
- Students who test positive should contact <u>covidresponse@wartburg.edu</u> to enact isolation protocols.

Isolation

- Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 should isolate for at least 5 days.
- Students who test positive should contact faculty for class accommodations.
- Students in residence halls are encouraged to go home, if possible. If that is not possible, please contact Residence Life (319-352-8260) for further guidance.
- Isolation will end after 5 days if the individual is fever-free for 24 hours (without medication) and symptoms are improving.
- Individuals will be required to wear a mask through day 10.
