## DR. KAREN BLACK

Dr. Karen Black is the Rudi Inselmann Endowed Professor of Organ at Wartburg College. She teaches organ and church music, music theory, and aural skills; serves as organist for Chapel services; and conducts Kantorei and the Handbell Choir. Black is active as a recitalist and clinician. She has published organ and choral arrangements with Augsburg Fortress and ECS Publishing. In 2021 she released an organ album, *Ein feste Burg*, on the ARSIS label, celebrating the 25th anniversary of the installation of the Wartburg College Chapel Dobson organ. Black currently serves as North Central Regional Councillor of the AGO.



## DR. MOLLY DORAN

Dr. Molly Doran, assistant professor of piano, joined the Wartburg faculty in 2021 and teaches musicology and applied piano. She earned her doctorate from Indiana University, a master's degree from Bowling Green University, and a bachelor's degree from Hillsdale College.



## DR. SUZANNE TORKELSON

Dr. Suzanne Torkelson, professor of piano at Wartburg, is the Iowa Repertoire List Chair, past West Central Division Director, past IMTA president, and served for many years as official accompanist for MTNA competitions. During her tenure at Wartburg, she has had IMTA state winners at every level A-F, numerous winners and junior co-winners of the Terrace Hill Endowment for the Arts scholarship, and four-time national finalists in the Music Teachers National Association competition. She has Master Teacher certification from MTNA, the highest level of professional certification, and is frequently asked to present master classes, festivals, new music sessions, and other pedagogy-related programs.

The Meistersinger Keyboard Camp for piano and organ students in grades 7-12 will be Sunday through Wednesday, July 24-27, on the Wartburg College campus. Students who attend receive instruction in piano, organ, music theory, and history as well as explore careers in music.

Each day culminates with an informal recital, and the camp ends in a recital open to the public.
