Terms of Payment

The Fall Term shall be considered as the first half of the year and the Winter/May terms as the second half. Monthly statements are made available via **my.wartburg.edu** and **CASHNet**. Payments are **due by Sept. 10** for Fall Term, **Feb. 10** for Winter Term, and **March 10** for May Term. Charges over 30 days old are subject to a finance charge. Payments can be made via cash, check, money order, bank wire, Flywire, or CASHNet. Monthly payment plans also are available. Housing assignments are made by the Residential Life Office after students complete and return a housing application. All listed room costs are at least double occupancy. A limited number of single rooms are available for an additional charge.

Board

All students living in campus residences are required to have a board plan. Meal plans are charged at the full amount, with any unused points rolling from one term to the next, through May Term. Any unused points at the end of May Term are nonrefundable. A special six-meal plan applies only to Knights Village residents.

Books and Supplies

Books and supplies for all courses may be purchased at The Wartburg Store. Average book costs for September through May are approximately \$1,100.
