- 1) View your Cooperating Teacher's portfolio (if they are required to have one).
- 2) Discuss some of the artifacts provided for evidence.
- 3) Discuss resources provided by the district to assist teachers with their evaluation process.

You may also use this exercise to have your Cooperating Teacher provide feedback on the artifacts and format for your Student Teaching portfolio. This portfolio is due at the end of the current term..
