Formed in 2010, Neave Trio-violinist Anna Williams, cellist Mikhail Veselov, and pianist Eri Nakamura-were recently nominated for a Grammy and have received prestigious accolades for their "engaging and cutting-edge performances." Educators are invited to come with their students for the day. A complimentary educator session with Neave Trio will take place at the start of the festival. With Neave Trio, the festival will provide a unique opportunity for string students to learn in both a large and chamber ensemble setting. Those on a piano track, will be given special masterclasses and performance opportunities with Neave Trio artist Eri Nakamura. Individual students and/or pre-formed chamber groups are invited to apply! Piano performers can be nominated through their studio teacher. This is a great opportunity for students to have feedback before performing their pieces for solo and ensemble contest and/or college auditions.

As an educator, you can submit your students for the following categories:

STRING TRACK

- 1. Submit ONLY individuals
- 2. Submit ONLY a chamber ensemble (up to 2 chamber ensembles)
- 3. Submit individuals and ONE chamber ensemble

PIANO TRACK

1. Submit ONLY individuals (Limit up to 2 per studio)

We will take as many chamber ensembles as space allows. Registration for the festival which includes lunch, is \$45. Access to the large ensemble festival music will be given via Google Drive by January 6. Pianists will be performing prepared pieces of their choosing.



The festival will begin at 9am on Saturday January 27 and will conclude with two concerts: **Piano** participants will perform in the Wartburg Chapel at 3:30pm and string participants will perform at 5pm in the Neumann Auditorium. Concert tickets will be available for purchase on our website on January 19, 2024.
