- 1. Choose one Social wicked problem that you want to think about, research on and tackle in this project.
- 2. The project needs to have the following sections:
 - 2.1. Statement of the problem that you are addressing
 - 2.2. How significant is the problem and solving it to you, your community, state, country and world?
 - 2.3. What are the costs and benefits of addressing such problem to the community?
 - 2.4. What resources do you need to implement your solution?
 - 2.5. Prepare a (creative) poster that promotes your selected problem, and proposed idea to solve it.
- 3. Identify areas that you need assistance to put your idea into practice.
- 4. Write a mini business plan around your proposed idea.
